



## Lockheed Martin Eagan Team Earns Top Corporate Honor

The solution represents an important step in meeting the critical need to unify air defense capabilities across the U.S.

The award will be presented to a team representative on September 27 at Lockheed Martin's Eighth Annual NOVA Awards, at the Smithsonian Institution's National Air & Space Museum in Washington, D.C. The NOVA award program was established in 1995 to recognize outstanding contributions to the corporation's mission and business objectives. Awards are made annually in four categories -- Exceptional Service, Leadership, Teamwork, and Technical Excellence -- to individuals or teams selected from Lockheed Martin's 125,000 employees.
