Settlement in cash or stock (as elected by the director) will occur upon the Reporting Person's retirement or termination of service, except that non-employee directors who have satisfied our stock ownership guidelines may elect to have payment begin on March 30 following vesting of the award.
- 3. End of period holdings include additional acquisitions through dividend reinvestment.
